TranExec and Bath University share the same values and intentions to deliver world-class research, teaching and education to students and participants to become future leaders, adaptive leaders and innovators.


'Women in Leadership and Organisational Coaching' program will present you with ideas, perspectives and new skills in a safe and stimulating environment.
